What is needed?

- Bristol A4 or Letter size (white or colored)
- Scissors
- Regular stapler
- Transparent Slide
- Internal cardboard from toilet roll
- For children: Colorful stickers



Important!

Although this product is very similar to products currently in the field, it has not been tested or approved officialy. This mask does not replace any other protection elements that you use but it can prevent touching of your face.

Using it is at your own responsibility.

After each use, the entire product should be cleaned with sanitizer.

You can also disassemble the slide from the paper structure to disinfect and make a new frame. It's so easy :-)



Instructions:

Cut 6 strips from the A4/Letter Bristol page about 3.5 cm - 1.4" wide.
 You can cut freely or print only pages #5 or #6 from this file.

Page #5 - A4 size Page #6 - Letter size



 Take 3 of the strips and staple them together to make a long ribbon.
 Do this to the other 3 strips.

End product: 2 long ribbons.




 Take one of the ribbons and place it around your head above your ears and staple to tightly fit the diameter of your head, thus creating a hoop.

Staple right and left leftover bristol strips to the

the outer sides of the hoop.



Flatten the hoop and open the hoop again.
 (See diagram - folds are numbered 1 & 2)










Take the second ribbon and fold in half (The purpose of this fold is to mark the midpoint).


Open the ribbon and place the center mark in line with the outside of fold **#1** created on the hoop and staple.







Cardboard toilet paper roll -Cut a ring of about 3 cm - 1.2" in hight (try not to squash the roll).





Attach the toilet paper ring to the second fold in the hoop, marked as #2.







 Close the open strap around the hoop and around the cardboard roll and staple.


Staple the leftover ribbon to both sides to the hoop.





 Attach the top center of the transparent slide to the front of the hoop and staple through the cardboard roll.
 Staple the left and right sides of

Staple the left and right sides of the transparent slide around the outer hoop on both sides.



Children Decorate the top, bottom and sides of the transparent slide.
